Security Benefits



- All students & staff on 1 campus
- Handicap Accessible

- More effective & reliable camera & PA system at the Oxford Street/High School campus
- Pick up/Drop Off more controllable by school officials to ensure a safer traffic environment.
- Newer building
- Larger Classrooms allow for options for safe areas in emergency situations as well as increased maximum occupancy
- Tactically safer school for law enforcement & emergency services

Currently, there is no safe way for law enforcement to enter the Third Street School due to the numerous blind spots & stairwells which can effect emergency operations. Basement level windows are unprotected for unauthorized access to the building.

Where are classes to be housed?

- PreK-5 classrooms will be in the current Oxford Street School.
- Grades 6-8 will be in the first floor front hallway of the high school as well as in 3 classrooms on the second floor of the high school.
- Transition time between classes will be staggered between middle & high school schedules so there is no common passing time.
- Media Center will be redesigned to service PreK-12 students & staff.
- Specials will remain in current rooms.
- Grades K-5 will eat lunch in the Oxford Street Multi-Purpose Room (current lunch location). Grades 6-8 will eat lunch in the High School Cafe (current lunch location). PreK will eat lunch in the classroom.
